We hope everyone had a restful and enjoyable break.

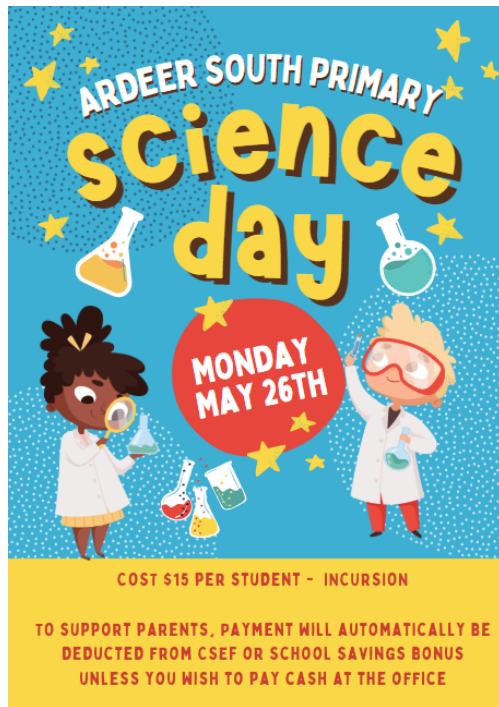
We're excited to begin Term 2 with fresh energy, new goals, and continued learning. Let's work together to make this term a positive, productive, and fun experience for all our students.
