## School Sandpit

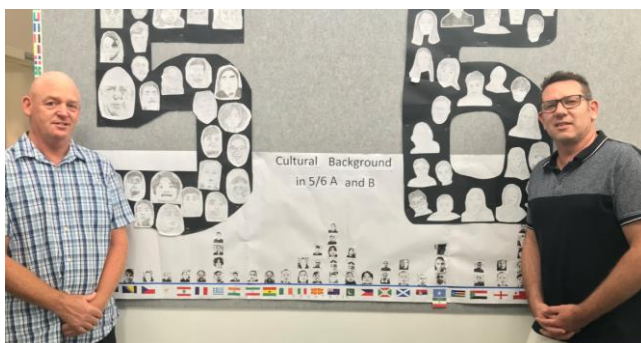
Thank you to Lisa (our incredible wellbeing Chaplin) who has provided sand pit toys for the students to play with at recess and lunch, they have been very popular.
